

# Beaded Chain Links



Below are a variety of charted designs that can be used for beaded chain links or bracelets. They can be worked in any combination of colours using size 11 seed beads or cylinder beads and measure approx. 19cm in length. Each length of beadwork can be stitched/zipped together along the short edges and interlinked together to form a chain. Alternatively each length can be made in to a bracelet, using popper studs to fasten, and can be interlinked together to form a temporary chain.

The charts are intended to be worked in Peyote stitch, starting from the left edge of the chart and can be worked to the desired length by adding or omitting rows on the right edge. A decorative picot edging can also be added to each long edge if desired. When working in Peyote stitch, it is easier to work in even count (i.e. twelve beads wide) and add the thirteenth column along the long edge in Brick stitch.
