



You will need:

- 1 – 2g size 15/Os
- 2 – 3g size 11/Os
- Approx. 46 x 4mm Firepolish
- Approx 8 x 3mm Firepolish
- Approx 32 x Kite beads
- Fastening of your choice
- Small piece of purl / French wire
- Thread or Fireline, Needle & bead mat

Step 1

- Thread your needle with a wingspan of thread – you will be using this singly
- ***Pick up 1 x 11/O – 1 x 4mm – 1 x 11/O and pass your needle through the hole at the narrow end of a kite
- Pick up 1 x 15/O – 1 x 11/O – 1 x 4mm – 1 x 11/O – 1 x 15/O and pass your needle through the hole at the narrow end of a new kite
- Repeat from ***
- Pass your needle through all the beads again and pull them into a circle
- Make a small knot to secure the circle and leave enough of a tail to add the fastening later
- Move your needle through the 1 x 11/O – 1 x 4mm – 1 x 11/O and hole of the first kite
- Now pass your needle back through the hole at the other end of the kite and you are in position for the next step



Step 2

- Pass your needle through the empty hole of the next kite and pick up 1 x 15/O
- Pass your needle through the hole of the next 2 kites and pick up 1 x 15/O
- Pass your needle through the hole of the kite where you started and pull gently so the fatter part of the kites all flip into the centre of the round
- Move your needle around all the beads again to tighten the round
- Now move your needle through the holes in the next 2 kites so it is coming out of the first 15/O you added in this round

Step 3

- Pick up 1 x 15/0 – 1 x 3mm – 1 x 15/0 and pass your needle through the 2nd 15/0
 - Pass your needle back through the 1 x 15/0 – 1 x 3mm – 1 x 15/0 and continue through the 15/0 where you first started
 - Pull the beads gently into place
 - Now we need to move our needle into position to add the joining crystals
- Continue to move your needle through the 2 x kites – 1 x 15/0 – 1 x kite
 - Now pass your needle back through the hole at the narrow end of this kite
 - Continue through the 1 x 15/0 – 1 x 11/0 – 1 x 4mm

Step 4

- Pick the following up 3 times – 1 x 15/0 – 1 x 4mm
- Now pick up 1 x 15/0 and pass your needle through the 4mm where you first started
- Pull the beads gently into a circle and pass your needle around through all the beads again to tighten
- Now move your needle through 1 x 15/0 – 1 x 4mm – 1 x 15/0 – 1 x 4mm and you are in position to start the next unit

Step 5

- Pick up 1 x 11/0 – 1 x 15/0 and pass your needle through the hole at the narrow end of a kite
- Pick up 1 x 11/0 – 1 x 4mm – 1 x 11/0 and pass your needle through the hole at the narrow end of a new kite
- Pick up 1 x 15/0 – 1 x 11/0 – 1 x 4mm – 1 x 11/0 – 1 x 15/0 and pass your needle through hole at the narrow end of a new kite
- Pick up 1 x 11/0 – 1 x 4mm – 1 x 11/0 and pass your needle through the narrow end of a kite
- Pick up 1 x 15/0 and 1 x 11/0 and pass your needle through the 4mm where you started
- Pull the beads gently into a circle and move your needle around through all the beads again to tighten
- Continue through the beads until your needle is coming out of the hole in the 2nd kite
- Now pass your needle back through the hole at the other end of this kite and you are in position for the next step





Step 6 – 8

- Repeat steps 2, 3 and 4

To continue

- Repeat steps 5 – 8 until you have the number of units until the bracelet is about 1 inch shorter than you need the finished length to be

NB You will finish on step 7

Add the Fastening

- With your thread coming out of the 4mm at the end of the bracelet, pick up 3 x 15 – 1 x 11/O – small piece of purl – first part of fastening
- Pass your needle back through the 11/O and pull the purl gently into a loop
- Pick up 3 x 15/O and pass your needle through the 4mm to where you first started
- Move your needle through the 6 x 15/O around the outside of the 4mm to strengthen then back through the 4mm
- Weave your thread into the bracelet and secure with a couple of knots
- Thread up your tail thread at the other end of the bracelet and add the 2nd part of the fastening in the same way



NB if you feel you need a bit more length on your fastening then you could add a crystal after the 11/O and before adding the purl



Earring options

- Make one unit following the instructions for steps 1 – 3
- Move your needle so it is coming out of one of the 4mm crystals on the side without the 15/Os
- Pick up 3 x 15/O – 1 x 11/O – 1 x 4mm – 1 x 11/O – piece of purl – earring wire
- Pass your needle back through the 1 x 11/O – 1 x 4mm – 1 x 11/O and pull the purl into a loop
- Pick up 3 x 15/O and pass your needle through the 4mm where you started, before weaving your thread into the beads and securing with a small know
- Weave in and secure your tail thread
